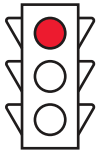

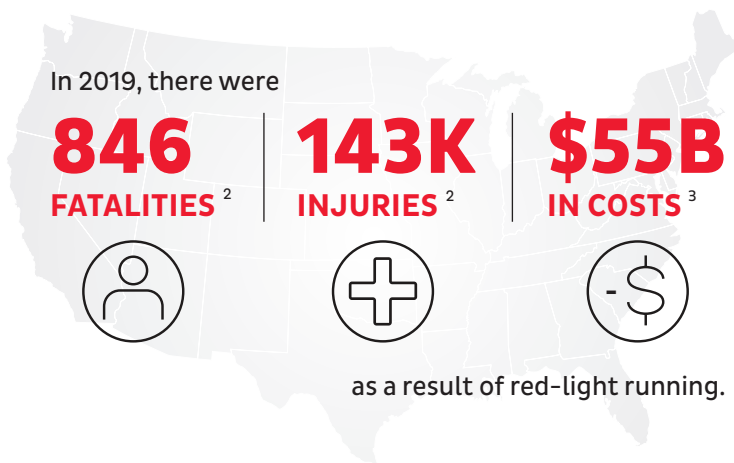

Red-Light Runners Take Lives.



1 IN 3 AMERICANS know someone who has been **injured or killed** in a red-light running crash.¹



1/2 OF RED-LIGHT RUNNING DEATHS are people other than the red-light runners.⁴

Red-Light Safety Cameras Save Lives.

Large cities with red-light safety cameras saw a

21% DECREASE in red-light running crashes compared to cities without cameras.²



Safety cameras significantly reduce red-light running. Oxnard, California and Fairfax, Virginia saw a

40% REDUCTION after the introduction of red-light safety cameras.²



Red-light safety camera programs in seven cities resulted in a

25% DECREASE in right-angle crashes⁵



and produced a positive aggregate economic benefit of more than

\$18.5M⁵

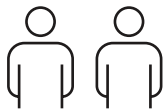

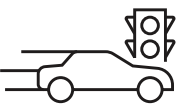
Red-Light Runners Take Lives.

in the U.S.⁶

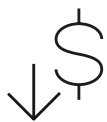


More than
50%
of the combined total of fatal
and injury crashes **occur at or**
near intersections.⁷



The most common type of
urban crashes involve
DRIVERS WHO RUN RED LIGHTS,
stop signs and other traffic controls.⁸

Costs to the Community.



Traffic crash deaths resulted in
\$55 BILLION
in medical and work loss costs in
addition to the immeasurable burden on
the victims' families and friends in 2018.⁹

Red-Light Safety Cameras **Save Lives.**

More than
340 COMMUNITIES
across the U.S. are **utilizing red-light**
safety cameras, making their
communities safer.⁸



A national poll showed
86% OF DRIVERS
said it's very or extremely dangerous
to speed through a red light.¹⁰



Funding to the Community.

More than
\$20 MILLION
from red-light running fines
has gone to spinal cord injury
research to cure paralysis.¹¹
